Hilary Houston will present on tax exempt facilities and the tax benefits in Ohio, as well as tips on preparing applications.

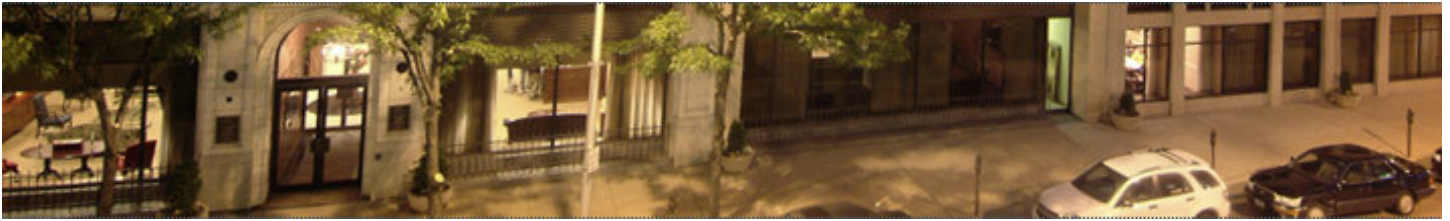
Jesse Cook-Dubin will speak on state tax considerations in the restructuring of debt and bankruptcy.
