


#### Does AI Change the Game?



- Don't fall for the hype
- Marketing promises to produce the best results, the best content with the best safeguards but the realities are falling short
- Potential to help is there . . . but for Al to be useful, it has to actually solve YOUR problem
- It's an opportunity to become more efficient

#### What We Have Done With the Opportunity

- Mapped workflows
- Identified areas for improved efficiency thru technology, staffing, vendor, or process changes
- Built multidisciplinary evaluation team, including security and compliance experts
- Considered whether to buy, build, or collaborate with a partner on solutions
- Set up a task force to evaluate tools
- Forced vendors into financial models that makes sense for adoption and change management
- Implemented training, productivity goals




## Security, Data Protection & Compliance

Security Area	Examples of What to Look For	
Certifications	SOC 2, ISO 27001	
Data Encryption	AES-256, HTTPS, encrypted storage	
Access Controls	Role-based, MFA, audit logs, SSO	
Penetration Testing	Regular, independent, documented	
Privacy & Data Use	No data sharing/training, clear ownership	
Incident Response	Documented plan, notification procedures	
Data Residency	Compliance with GDPR, CCPA, etc.	
Integration Security	Secure APIs	
Contractual Protections	DPAs, indemnity, exit/data return clauses

#### What We Are Seeing: Litigation Tools

 Infringement detection – heavy area of development, with lots of marketing promises; more difficult challenge because reviewing current internet data that is not detailed enough to determine infringement


#### Claim charts

- Patent searching for patentability has some strong tools
- Quick claim charts for marketing purposes
- Detailed claim charts that would go straight into a brief . . . Nah.
- Legal research Lexis Al . . . great to drill or answer specific questions
- Discovery and doc review tools


## AI - What's the Potential Savings Impact?

	Initial Possibilities	Eventually
Prep	5%	20-30%
Pros	5-10%	20-40%
Litigation (sans discovery tools)	3-5%	7-10% (Gen 3???)
Process Flow	Not there yet	20%+

#### Summary

- Don't believe the hype there is no magic button tool that will solve your process flow or portfolio management challenges
  - Identify the problems and THEN evaluate the solution (technology, staffing, process, etc.)
  - Align use of new tools and approaches with long-term growth strategies, risk tolerances, and client needs
- Al IP tools are still piecemeal solutions with differing levels of sophistication along the development curve, but they are rapidly evolving
- For adoption, there is a steep learning curve for folks to use and incorporate into workflows
- Pricing models are based on traditional licensing that is not conducive to adoption
