Our appellate work includes cases that the firm handled at trial as well as cases in which the firm has been retained after trial. In addition, we often file *amicus curiae* briefs for clients who have an important stake in the outcome of an appeal to which they are not a party. Our emphasis in all of our appellate work is on accurate, thoughtful and persuasive presentation of the dispositive legal issues based on the appellate record, through concise briefs and focused oral argument.
